Presentation Dinner

The title is a tad misleading as our Presentation Night will actually be a weekend. The venue is Lake Waranga Caravan Park on Saturday 2nd of June. While we will be out in the country, you still need to get dressed up for it. We will start with some nibbles around 5pm and the presentations for the kids starting at 6pm. Dinner will be a 3 course meal with BYO all drinks bar tea and coffee. We will have Best Presented Boats on display, music and some games to play. All this will take place in the Holiday Camp within the Caravan Park. There is a separate room within the building where the kids can go and watch DVDs if they're getting bored later in the night. Once the presentations are done, there will be a fire outside for those who want it so bring a chair. Accommodation in the Holiday Camp building is dormitory style. Each of the rooms hold 3 bunks, i.e. 6 people. Where possible, we will keep groups/families to their own rooms but we may need people to share. The bunks have mattresses on them but you will need to bring pillows, sleeping bags or any other bedding you want. Toilets and showers are in the building in one block. If you want to stay in the Holiday Camp building you need to indicate on the form and pay with the tickets. Allocation of rooms will be done on the first in best dressed principle. The cost for adults is \$20 and kids U/16 \$10. Alternatively you can camp on the grounds of the Holiday Camp without power. If you need power you will need a site in the Caravan Park. There are also cabins and onsite vans in the park you can book. If you are going to stay powered, un-powered, cabin or onsite van, you will need to book directly with the park. Their no. is 03 58561243 and mention you're with the club. The cost for the meal is \$30 for adults, \$22 for kids U/12 and kids U/4 are free. This gets you a 3 course meal and nibbles on Saturday night and breakfast on Sunday morning so all you need to do is bring your drinks in your eskies. Available on the night will be a DVD of the regatta. Sally Moody took over 800 photos which Karen Joseph will format onto a DVD. If you want a copy, indicate on the form and you be able to pick it up on the night. Last year we had 27 people turn up which was bloody pathetic so you all need to turn up this year to redeem yourselves, no excuses. Make sure you send your replies to Chris Boyle, not the Clubs P.O. 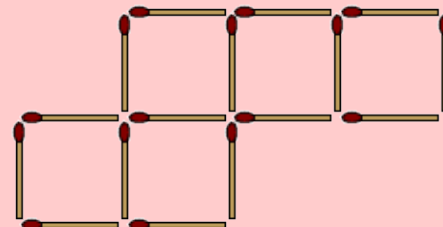

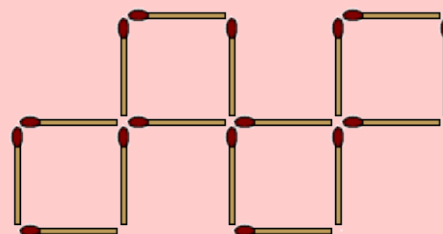
Matchstick Puzzle Solutions

Puzzle 1:



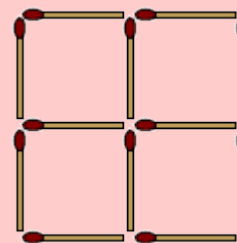
Move two matchsticks to make only four identical squares.

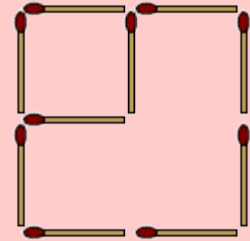

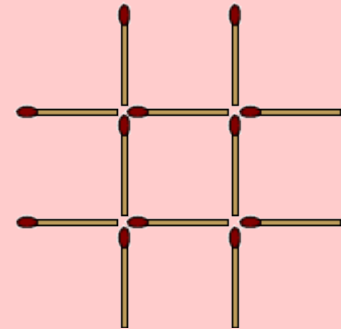

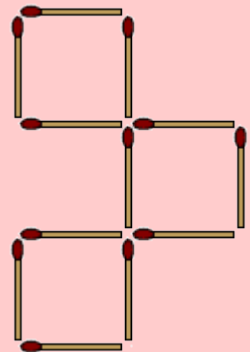
Here is the solution. This would have been even simpler, if I had mentioned that the starting diagram showed five squares.
