HOLESHOT

Made by H. Foster in 1963, "Holeshot" is a 14'1, Seacraft 140.



The first ever owners of Holeshot were a family called the Kramers who bought Holeshot brand new in 1963. They were big into motor cross riding and named her Holeshot, which is a term of being 'First out of the gate'.

The second owner was Morry Platt, who owned her for 4-5 years.

The third owner was a man named Gavin Moore, who bought her when he was 19 years old. Coffo built him a motor and raced it in the VSTC around 1990, towing a young man named Adam Carne, against the likes of the Rowley's and Drag On. And won the Little Stock Class that year.

We bought Holeshot from Gavin Moore in 2012, before our other boat Muddy Waters was about to be given a makeover. Gavin had owned Holeshot for approximately 25 years prior.
